DROP OFF & PICK UP: BUS RIDERS

****Staff and parent/escort must wear masks during check in/check out. ****

Drop off/Check-in

- a. Parents will wait in their cars at the bus stop until the bus arrives and the staff person waives you over or comes to your car.
- b. On the first day of each week, the escort will provide the staff person with the health check in sheet. On subsequent days, the child and escort must attest to the fact that there are no changes to the submitted pre-camp health screening.
- c. While in the car the child's temperature will be checked and if the temp is under 100.3, the child can be signed in.
- d. If the child's temperature is over 100.3 the child will be unable to attend camp. The child must be fever free for 72 hours, with no other symptoms, without the use of medication. Please consult the Director for guidance.
- e. If child's temperature is below 100.3, the child will be signed in.
- f. On Monday, they will be provided a "color" as their designated cohort.

Riding the bus

- a. All campers will have hand sanitizer applied to their hands before boarding the bus.
- b. All campers will be required to wear masks on the bus to and from camp. Each child will be assigned a seat for the week, alternating inside and outside with backpacks on opposite area. Only those children residing in the same household will be allowed to sit together.
- c. Upon arrival at camp, campers will be dropped off at the bottom of the hill and will walk up to their assembly area (according to their color and designated by a flag.)
 1. Red - Pavilion stage area
 2. Yellow - Mid-camp assembly area
 3. Green - Fire Circle

Pick up/Bus Stops

- a. Upon arrival at bus stops, parents will remain in vehicle.
- b. When the bus arrives, parent may get out of the car to meet their child. Please continue to maintain appropriate physical distancing from other parents/families, and wear a mask.
- c. The bus will remain at the stop until the designated drop off time. If an escort is not at the stop, the staff will call the emergency number. We are unable to wait for tardy parents, but will notify the camp director and designate an area for the child to wait. Please ensure that an escort is waiting at the bus stop at the appropriate time.

**** As stated in the parent handbook, changes to your designated pick up or drop off location must be approved through the camp office at least 24 hrs in advance, including picking up your child from camp.

Bus Care

- a. All buses will be sanitized before every run.
- b. Windows will remain open whenever possible to allow air flow.
- c. Drivers, staff and campers will wear facial coverings while on the bus.



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DROP OFF & PICK UP: CAR RIDERS

Drop off/ check in

- a. Parents will park in the designated drop off area inside the gate - on the right side.
- b. Children and parents should remain in their cars until staff person checks them in.
- c. On the first day of each week, the escort will provide the staff person with the health check in sheet. On subsequent days, the child and escort must attest to the fact that there are no changes to the submitted pre-camp health screening.
- d. While in the car, the child's temperature will be checked. If the temp is under 100.3, the child can be signed in. All campers will have hand sanitizer applied to their hands.
- e. If the child's temperature is over 100.3 the child will be unable to attend camp. The child must be fever free for 72 hours, with no other symptoms, without the use of medication. Please consult the Director for guidance.
- f. On Monday, they will be provided a "color" as their designated cohort.
- g. Campers will walk up to their assembly area (according to their color and designated by a flag.)
 1. Red - Pavilion stage area
 2. Yellow - Mid-camp assembly area
 3. Green - Fire Circle

Pick up

- a. Escorts should arrive and park in the designated area on the right, inside the gate.
- b. Please remain in your car.
- c. Riders are dismissed from their assembly area to proceed to the pick up area at the bottom of the hill - escorted by camp staff.

**** As stated in the parent handbook, any changes to your designated pick up or drop off time must be approved through the camp office at least 24 hrs in advance.

DROP OFF & PICK UP: BEFORE/AFTER CAMP

****Staff and parents must wear masks during drop off/pick up. ****

- a. Parents may drive up to the top of the hill between 8am and 8:40am, and between 4:20pm and 5:00pm.
- b. During drop off, children and parents should remain in their cars until staff person checks them in.
- c. On the first day of each week, the escort will provide the staff person with the health check in sheet. On subsequent days, the child and escort must attest to the fact that there are no changes to the submitted pre-camp health screening.
- d. While in the car, the child's temperature will be checked. If the temp is under 100.3, the child can be signed in. All campers will have hand sanitizer applied to their hands.
- e. If the child's temperature is over 100.3 the child will be unable to attend camp. The child must be fever free for 72 hours, with no other symptoms, without the use of medication. Please consult the Director for guidance.
- f. On Monday, they will be provided a "color" as their designated cohort.
- g. For pick up, escort should remain in the car and you child will be brought to your car for check out.
