Position: Y-ASPIRE Program Assistant Reports To: Site Director

General Function:

- ☐ Serve as the co-leader of the designated site in the Y-ASPIRE program
- ☐ Support the Site Director and program participants
- ☐ Model the YMCA Mission and 4 Core Values: Respect, Responsibility, Caring & Honesty

Direct Responsibilities:

- 1. Work with the Site Director to provide a program in accordance with outcome objectives and expectations
- 2. Provide safe & nurturing care to all program participants as per YMCA policies & procedures
- 3. Assist with daily snack
- 4. Communicate as necessary with Y-ASPIRE participants and the Site Director on issues of safety, behavioral problems and/or any other concerns
- 5. Help ensure that the spaces used for the program are left as they were when the group entered them
- 6. Attend staff meetings

Qualifications:

- 1. Should have child care, education, youth development or related experience
- 2. Must submit to and pass a State "Records Check Authorization"
- 3. Able to be certified in CPR and First Aid

Hours of Employment:

Program Assistants work from the time that the local elementary school closes (it varies from school-to-school, generally between 2:45 and 3:00) until 5:00 pm. They will also work all or most of the day when schools are closed for vacations, teacher in-service training and some holidays, as well as for half-days when schools close early due to bad weather or teacher in-service training.
